DISCUSSION QUESTIONS BLESS: Eat & Serve

- 1. How does the idea of "eating as mission" challenge the way you currently think about evangelism?
- 2. What are some of your most meaningful memories that happened around a table? Why do you think those moments stuck with you?
- 3. What point was Jesus making when he said that he "came eating and drinking..." (Luke 7:34)? What does this say about how he wanted to know others and be known?
- 4. Jesus was often criticized for eating with "sinners." What does this says about his approach to relationships and evangelism?
- 5. In what ways can your table become a tool for mission and ministry? Are there barriers—practical, emotional, or otherwise—that keep you from using it that way?
- 6. Daniel mentioned that eating with others affirms their dignity and value. Can you think of someone in your life who might need that kind of affirmation?
- 7. Read John 13:1-17 together. Why did Jesus choose to wash his diciples' feet the night before his crucifixion? How would you have felt if you had been there?
- 8. Jesus said He came to serve, not to be served (Mark 10:45). What does that kind of servant-hearted love look like in your context—home, work, school, neighborhood?
- 9. What are some small, everyday ways you could integrate serving others into your normal routine?
- 10. How can your small group support each other in living out this kind of missional lifestyle?
- 11. In what ways does serving others help you understand more deeply the heart and character of Jesus?
