Evangelism & The Gospel

1. What is your favorite story of all time? What images or thoughts come to your mind when you hear the words “evangelize” and “convert”? How does understanding the gospel as a story change the way we view evangelism?
2. What does it mean to be “reconciled to God,” and how does that impact our role in evangelism?
3. Have you ever missed (or taken!) an opportunity to talk about your faith? What do you think keeps us from recognizing or stepping into those moments?
4. If someone were to ask you, “what does it mean to love your neighbor?” How would you respond?
5. What is your greatest fear or frustration when it comes to loving people and sharing the good news of Jesus with those around you? How can we overcome the fear or intimidation that often comes with evangelism?
6. Why is it important that the gospel doesn’t just stay with us but is shared with others?
7. How does it feel to think about identifying your “Top 5”? Is it exciting, intimidating, or something else—and why?
8. Based on the brief description of B.L.E.S.S. in this session, which of these do you think will come easiest to you and which will require more effort?
9. What do you think it means to join God in his mission in the world? How does that change the way we see our everyday relationships?
10. Who in your life has been the greatest B.L.E.S.S.ing to you in your faith? How can you emulate them as you seek to love the people around you?
