DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

In the Home

Opening Discussion

- Share some insights from your SHAPE results.
- When you think about purpose or calling, where does your mind first think that applies?
- Who are the people in your “home” right?
- What roles do you play in your home? (e.g. husband, wife, father, mother, son, daughter, brother, sister, roommate, friend, etc.)

Read Joshua 24:14-15

- What does it mean to “fear the Lord and serve him in sincerity and in faithfulness”?
- How is putting away gods/idols related to fear and serve the Lord?
- What are some examples of idols in our culture today?
- How do these idols impact the home?
- What does it practically look like to make this same declaration for your household?
- How would you describe the current culture of your home? What aspects reflect your faith, and what areas need attention?

Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9

- If someone observed your daily life for a week, what would they say you truly love and prioritize?
- Why it is important that the command to love God comes before any instruction about passing faith on to the next generation?
- Deuteronomy 6:7 calls us to teach God’s truth “when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.” What are some practical, everyday moments where you could naturally incorporate faith conversations in your home?

Application

- How can you intentionally shape the culture of your home? What’s one specific, practical step you can take this week to better fear and serve the Lord in your home?
- For those without children at home (empty nesters, singles, young adults): How can you use your influence to shape the next generation of the church or invest in your extended family?

Closing Reflection

- How can this group pray for you as you seek to shape the culture of your home for God’s kingdom?
